

Suwon Hwaseong Fortress

Address: 320-2 Yeonghwa-dong, Jangan-gu, Suwon-si, Gyeonggi-do

Suwon Hwaseong Fortress is a historic landmark recognized for its profound cultural significance and was designated as a UNESCO World Cultural Heritage site in 1967, a testament to its outstanding universal value.

The fortress was designed with scientific and practical principles, reflecting the philosophy of Silhak (Practical Learning), an intellectual movement that emphasized empirical studies and practical application.

Hwaseong Haenggung Palace

Hwaseong Haenggung Palace is a temporary palace located within Suwon Hwaseong Fortress and served as King Jeongjo's residence during his visits to Suwon.

Renowned as one of the largest and most beautiful royal temporary palaces from the Joseon Dynasty.

Visitors can experience traditional Korean culture through various performances held daily.

Activities to Enjoy in Suwon Hwaseong Fortress

Step back in time and experience **traditional Korean archery**, a martial art deeply rooted in Korean history.

This activity takes place at Yeonmudae (also known as Dongjangdae) within Suwon Hwaseong Fortress.

This very spot was a military training ground where soldiers of Jangyongyeong, King Jeongjo's royal guard, honed their martial skills over 220 years ago.

Activities to Enjoy in Suwon Hwaseong Fortress

For a truly unique perspective of Suwon Hwaseong Fortress, the **Flying Suwon hot air balloon** offers an unparalleled aerial adventure.

This distinctive attraction ascends approximately 150 meters above ground, providing breathtaking panoramic views of the entire fortress and the cityscape.

Mon't Worry!

The large helium-filled balloon does not stray too far as it is operated from a fixed location. Due to the nature of helium, it is light and safe. It's 32m high and 22m wide and can accommodate a maximum of 20 people and move up to 70m~150m.

Activities to Enjoy in Suwon Hwaseong Fortress

Hwaseong Fortress Tourist Trolley is a unique tour shuttle that operates on a circular route, connecting the main tourist points of Suwon Hwaseong Fortress.

It was specially designed with motifs inspired by Emperor Sunjong's automobile and the palanquins (royal sedan chairs) used by Joseon Dynasty kings.

Tour Course:

①Yeonmudae → ②Hwahongmun→ ③Janganmun → ④Hwaseomun → ⑤Maehyang Bridge → ⑥Yeonmudae

* All passengers are free to disembark at all stops on the course, except for Janganmun




